SCHEDULE LP

LARGE POWER SERVICE

Available to consumers located on or near Cooperative's three-phase line for all types of usage, subject to the established rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

RATE PER MONTH

<u>RATE</u> \$20.70 per month per KW of billing demand, plus energy charges of:

*0.0894per KWH for the first 50 KWH used per month per KW of billing demand

*\$0.0515 per KWH for all remaining KWH used per month.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND

The billing shall be the maximum kilowatt demand established by the consumer for any period fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, but not less than 30 KW as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as follows:

POWER FACTOR

The consumer agrees to maintain an average power factor of not less than 90%. The Cooperative reserves the right to measure such power factor at any time. Should such measurements indicate that the average power factor of the consumer is less than 90% the consumer agrees, upon sixty (60) days written notice, to correct such power factor to 90% or if the Cooperative shall so elect, the horsepower or demand for billing purposes shall be increased 1% by which the average power factor is less than 90% lagging.

WHOLESALE ADJUSTMENT CHARGE

In the event the rate under which the Cooperative purchases power at wholesale is adjusted, the Cooperative may make a corresponding modification in the above rate schedule.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge shall be the highest one of the following charges as determined for the consumer in question:

- (1) The minimum monthly charge specified in the contract for service.
- (2) A charge of \$2.00 per KVA of installed transformer capacity.
- (3) A charge of \$621.00 (30 KW @ \$20.70/KW)

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
